1. Currently be a high school senior
2. Be a PTSA member
3. Maintain a 2.0 grade point average
4. Be college bound (2 year, 4 year, or vocational institution) in the state of Michigan
5. Participate in PTA/PTSA activities

Process: Check off the following items as you complete them:

- Complete application.
- Attach high school transcript.
- Attach letters of recommendation.
- Attach essay.
- Have PTSA president verify that PTSA unit is in good standing.
- Have PTSA president sign and date application.
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- Send application and support materials to designated address.

Only applications RECEIVED BY JANUARY 15, 2010 will be forwarded to the Michigan PTSA Scholarship Committee for review.
